NOTIFICATION

Subject: Income Certificate with respect to revision of fees in the National Institutes of Technology (NITs) as per decision of the Council of NITs.

As per the orders received from the GOI, MHRD vide their letter F.No.33-4/2014-TS.III dated June 24, 2016 and July 07, 2016, the exemption of fees for various categories of students willing / eligible to take admission in B.Techprogramme 2016-2017 will provisionally be as under:

- a) Waiver of fee for candidates belonging to SC, ST and PwD / PH categories valid certificate signed by the competent authority not below the rank of the SDO/SDM.
- b) Income Certificate for full exemption of tuition fees for income upto Rupees One lakh and 2/3rd exemption of tuition fee for income between Rupees One Lakh and below Rupees Five Lakhs per annum, duly issued on or after 01/04/2016 by the Income Certificate Issuing Authority as per the list given in Annexure-I of this notification.

The above certificates are only provisional, in the absence of laid down policy from the competent authority. Any revision of the above by the competent authority at a later date, will have to be adhered to and certificate from such authority would have to be obtained and submitted by the concerned students within stipulated time frame, failing which they will have to deposit the entire amount of tuition fee. An Undertaking to this effect will have to be signed and submitted by the students at the time of admission to B.Tech/B.Archprogramme 2016-2017.
