- 1. A student who gets 'F' grade and fulfill the requirement of minimum 75% attendance in a course shall be eligible to supplementary examination.
- 2. A student will be allowed to undertake such examination only once in any course.

 No second chance shall be given. In case a student fails to qualify, he will be allowed to register in the regular course as and when offered.
- 3. The Supplementary Examination will be scheduled every academic year <u>back to back</u> with even semester examination.
- 4. Supplementary examination will be offered by the concerned department on the recommendation of Dean(Academic). The examination will normally offered by the same teacher who taught the regular course. However, HOD may assign some other faculty member in the event of some exigency, subject to the approval of Chairman, Senate.
- 5. Supplementary examination will have the same weightage as end semester examination vis-a-vis sessional.
- 6. While finalizing the grade for a course based on supplementary examination sessional marks already secured by the candidate in that course will be taken into account.
- 7. Under supplementary examination system improvement in sessional can be made only through registration in regular course.
- 8. This provision of supplementary examination will come into force for courses opted by students under different programmes from academic session 2011-12 onwards.
