Teaching schedule and Examination scheme etc. submitted by the various Heads of Departments were also discussed and approved by the Senate as per Annexures shown against each ecurse (attached with the agenda).

Ministry of Human Resource and Development. Govt, of India New Delhi may be requested to grant fellowship scholarship to 10 Nos students for each M. Tech. course  $\tilde{g}$  Rs.5000 per month. It was also decided that after two years, the progress of M. Tech. Programmes will be reviewed to start more M. Tech. Programmes in each discipline

The Dissertation Thesis Code (700) in M. Toch. Programme will be uniform for all Departments. The Heads of various Departments will make necessary corrections in their Schemes and send the corrected copy of the scheme to Dean (Academiz) for further necessary action. The subject Code for M Fech. in CAD of Microarchitecture of Electronics & Comm. Engineering Department shall be 'ID'.

TEM NO.4.3 WEIGHTAGE OF DIFFERENT SEMESTER AWARDS TOWARDS BARCH, DEGREE.

The Senate has authorized the HOD. Architecture to obtain detailed information within 15 days from IIT. Roorkee, IIT. Kharagpur and School of Planning and Architecture. New Delhi regarding the procedure being followed by these Institution for the award of B. Architecture Degree. The Senate further authorized the Director & Chairman of Senate to take decision in this regard in consultation with the Dean(Academic) & Head, Department of Architecture after getting information from the above named Institutions.

APPROVAL FOR CHANGES IN THE STRUCTURAL ANALYSIS II (CE-214) AND STRUCTURAL ANALYSIS II (CE-221) COURSES.

ITEM NO. 4.5 REGARDING CREDIT IN THE SUBJECT OF ENGINEERING ECONOMICS (HU-201) OF MECHANICAL ENGINEERING 2 NO YEAR 4<sup>1H</sup> SEMESTER AT PAR WITH THE OTHER DEPARTMENTS.

ITEM NO.4.6 PROVISION FOR IMPROVEMENT OF SGPI AND CGPI.

After detailed discussion the Senate has resolved that the decision taken by the Standing Committee of Senate vide item No.2 of its meeting held on 30-8-2004 regarding improvement of SGPI and CGPI in respect of the candidates who have SGPI less than 4.5 and CGPI less than 5.0, may be implemented as a special case for the present semester only. However, for future such candidates will be given. Self. Study Course for improvement of their SCIPI CGPI and the evaluation process will remain the same as for regular students.

ITEM NO.4.7 REPLACEMENT OF PCB LAB" BY "EMBEDDED SYSTEM LAB" IN 6<sup>111</sup> SEMESTER IN THE ELECTRONICS AND COMMUNICATION ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT.

The recommendation of Standing Committee of Senate to replace the existing 'PCB LAB" by "Embedded Lab" of Electronics & Communication Engineering Department in 6th semester has been ratified by the Senate.

ITEM.NO.4.8 APPROVAL TO PERMIT THE CANDIDATES HAVING BACK-LOG TO REPEAT THE BACK-LOG SUEJECT/COURSE ONLY DURING THE SEMESTER IN WHICH THAT COURSE IS BEING RUN.

The Senate has ratified the decision taken by the Standing Committee of Senate vide item No.4 of its 5th meeting held on 30-8-2004 to permit the students who have to clear their back-log to repeat the subject only during the semester in which that course(s) is are being run. In case the candidate has no attendance shortage during the semester in which that course was studied earlier then he will not be enforced to attend the regular classes but the other requirements like Mid Term Examination and Class Tests etc. shall have to be completed by such candidate(s) at par with regular students.

ITEM.NO.4.9 MID TERM EXAMINATION IN THE SUBJECT OF ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN.

The Senate has approved that on analogy with other Institutes, where the Architecture course is being run, the centralized Mid Term Examination for the subject of Architectural Design may be discontinued and in lieu of the same, class Test be given by the concerned Teacher.

ITEM NO.4.10 EVALUATION OF MAJOR DESIGN PROJECT(THESIS DESIGN) SESSIONAL WORK AND PAYMENT OF HONORARIUM TO EXTERNAL EXAMINERS.

The Senate has resolved that as per the procedure being followed in IIT Kharagpur, the performance of various activities involved in the Project would be assessed individually at the end of each semester in which it is being carried out as per the curriculum. The student is required to submit a written report at the end of the semester. The Head of Department would appoint a Project Evaluation Board for the purpose of assessment. The Project Evaluation Board of the 10th semester would include an External Expert to be appointed by the Director from a panel recommended by the HOD.

The different components of evaluation and weights assigned to these components will be as under:-

i) Supervisor's assesment :40%

ii) Project Report/Thesis :20% (to be assessed by the board)

iii) Evaluation Board's assesment :40%

The student is required to give a seminar on the project work done. The evaluation board would conduct the viva-voce. Dates for conducting the seminar and the viva voce, to be held within ten days after the end-semester examination, would be announced in the academic calendar.

project report at the end of eighth semester for B. Tech. Degree or tenth semester for B. Arch Degree and does not appear before the evaluation board for the viva voce on the date fixed by the department in conformity with the academic calendar, may be granted extension of time not exceeding two months on the following conditions:

- i) He She would be awarded one grade lower than the grade obtained by him her and
- ii) He She would be deemed to have completed the requirements for the degree if applicable in the succeeding session.

The Head of the Department would constitute the Viva Voce Board(s) for conducting the comprehensive viva voce examination as per the requirement of the curriculum. The Board would decide the relative weights of the different aspects of the viva voce and decide the grades to be awarded to the students. The dates of the viva voce, to be conducted within ten days after the previous end semester examination, would be announced in the academic calendar.

It was further resolved that the External Examiner will be paid remuneration as under:-

- i) Upto 15 candidates Rs.500/-(Five hindered)
- ii) For more than 15 and upto 30 candidates Rs.1000'-(one thousands)

THE EXTERNAL EXAMINER WILL NOT EXAMINE MORE THAN 20 CANDIDATES IN A DAY.

The Senate also decided to enhance the Examination fee from Rs.300/- to 500/- per semester w.e.f the Even Semester starting from January, 2005.

#### ITEM NO.4.11 CHARGES FOR PREPARATION OF TRANSCRIPTS.

The Senate has approved that the fee for preparation/issue of ranscripts to students of NIT, Hamirpur shall be charged as under:-

1. Transcripts (under grade scheme)

a Rs. 75/-per copy

(Post 2006 Graduates)

2. Transcript (under old scheme)

a Rs.150/-per copy

(Graduate/graduating during 1990 to 2006)

The Institution will prepare the Transcripts and in no case the students will be asked to prepare and submit the transcripts themselves.
