# TO CHANGE THE NAME OF ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AS ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT.

- (1) The matter was discussed at length and it was decided that the name of the Department will remain as Electrical Engineering but degree will be awarded in Electrical & Electronics Engineering.
- (2) The request of final year students to award the degree in Electrical & Electronics Engineering from the Academic Session 2005-06 was discussed and it was decided to constitute a committee comprising of the following:-
- (i) Dean (Academic)
- (ii) Head, Electrical Engineering Department
- (iii) Head, Electronics & Communication Engineering Department
- (iv) Registrar-cum-Secretary, Senate

The committee will examine the variation in the course content of Electronics in the existing scheme as well as revised scheme of Electrical Engineering Department. If the variation of Electronics component is within 10 to 15% between the two schemes then the degree of Electrical & Electronics may be recommended to BOG for awarding to the students passing out in May/June-2006.
