MINUTES OF 1ST EMERGENT SENATE MEETING HELD THROUGH EMAIL CIRCULATION ON DATE 22ND MAY, 2020 (FRIDAY).

AGENDA ITEM WISE DECISIONS OF 1ST EMERGENT SENATE MEETING

EMERGENT SENATE/MIN/01/05-2020/01: To consider and approve criterion to workout number of seats for admission to PhD programme.

The Clause 8.1 of Ordinances for PhD programmes at point No.5 provides that normally a faculty member shall not supervise more than six PhD Research Scholars (including independent and shared Research Scholars) at a given point of time with a rider on maximum number of MHRD/ other ministries of Government of India funded fellowships decided by the Institute from time to time.

To this end, while taking due note of scarce fund availability during these years it is proposed that the number of MHRD (including MeitY) funded seats per department shall be 1.5 times the number of faculty members eligible for PhD supervision in that department. In the process every eligible faculty member will have one or at the most two MHRD/MeitY funded PhD Research Scholar(s) at given point of time. While working out vacant MHRD/MeitY funded seats for admission to PhD programme it will be eligible faculty based quota minus occupied seats in that department in the same category.

DECISION:

The Hon'ble members of the SENATE approved the proposal to workout number of seats for admission to Ph.D programmes, through email.

EMERGENT SENATE/MIN/01/05-2020/02:

Special Provisions to Manage Academic Activities and Examination of Final Year UG and PG Students, and PhD Scholars in Final Stage, in the wake of COVID-19 Pandemic.

Keeping in view the directives issued by the Government of India for COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdowns, all educational institutions shall remain closed. Also, MHRD has issued directions on the issues related to the examination for avoiding academic loss and taking appropriate actions in the interest of students. The point wise provisions for the same is given as under:-

A. Fulfilment of Attendance Requirement

It shall be assumed that all students fulfil the minimum attendance requirement of 75% i.e. there shall be no case of short attendance.

B. Evaluation of UG Final Year (8th Semester B.Tech./Dual Degree and 10th Semester B.Arch.)

D. Evaluation of Final Stages of PhD Programme

Unless, on-campus academic activities resume for PhD scholars, the following recommendations are made:

- PhD Oral Examination:** PhD scholar may be allowed to appear for Oral Examination through Skype or other online mode after observing codal formalities with regard to approval as per applicable clauses of Doctoral Ordinances. The approval may be sought through e-Office or as hardcopy by concerned supervisor. The thesis may be submitted as softcopy (duly signed and scanned). However, the hardcopies (as mentioned in Doctoral Ordinances) are to be submitted by the PhD scholar on resumption of academic activities in the campus.
- PhD Thesis Evaluation:** Thesis evaluation report submitted by the examiners as softcopy (signed pdf) shall be accepted.
- PhD Thesis Submission:** The PhD Thesis may be submitted as pdf (signed and scanned copy) through the supervisor.
- PhD Open Seminar:** Eligible and willing PhD scholar may be allowed to deliver Open Seminar through Skype or other online mode after observing codal formalities with regard to eligibility and approval as per applicable clauses of Doctoral Ordinances. The scholar shall submit request through email and supervisor & HoD shall move the case through e-Office or as hardcopy. The duly signed evaluation report may be submitted as softcopy (pdf).
- Exemption/extension in time period for various activities such as Conducting Comprehensive Examination, Delivering State-of-the-Art Seminar and Open Seminar, Submission of PhD Thesis and Conduction of Oral Examination, shall be suitably considered on receipt of request from the scholar with proper justifications.
