After detailed deliberations on the issue, the FC resolved that e-tenders be invited and the selection of OEMs/Vendors be made in a transparent and competitive way as per the provisions under GFRs and the CVC guidelines on transparency.

## FC/MIN/22/2016-09/14

To approve the major decisions taken by the Senate in its  $23^{rd}$  meeting held on  $27^{th}$  February, 2016.

After deliberations, the FC desired to seek information about the practice being followed by other sister institutes (IITs/NITs) in respect of Senate Resolution Nos. 23.10, 23.13 & 23.27. However, the FC ratified/recommended Senate Resolution No. 23.7 & 23.8 and for Resolution No. 23.28, the FC desired to carry on the Mentor Programme for UG entrants without remuneration.

#### FC/MIN/22/2016-09/15

To approve the major decisions of 23rd meeting of BWC held on 19th August, 2016.

The members from MHRD indicated that ideally the minutes of the 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the BWC should be placed for consideration before the FC after their confirmation/finalization in the next meeting of the BWC. However, on the insistence of the Director, they were taken up as an exception.

On being requested, the Director clarified that all the works including those of repair & maintenance as recommended by the BWC are essential, as per the actual site requirements and the cost estimates are based on the prevailing schedule rates.

After detailed deliberations on the issue, the FC resolved that the priorities of various new/ongoing works be listed out for execution within the allocation of around Rs. 5.00 Crore during the year 2016-17. Accordingly the FC recommended the decisions of  $23^{rd}$  BWC for approval by the Board in respect of works at Sr. 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14, 15, 18, 19 & 21 and desired to drop the proposals at Sr. No. 2, 3, 8, 9, 12, 13, 16, 17, 20, -22 & 23 for the time being.

The FC further felt that from Item No.22.1 of the BWC, it seems that the work related to the Boys Hostel has been split up into internal work, external work, site development work, sewerage, solar panel system etc. The FC desired that the reasons for the same be placed before the FC in its next meeting.
