Evaluation scheme for UG and PG students (except final year) and PhD scholars in the wake of COVID-19 pandemic

In suppression to Notification No. NIT/HMR/Academic/32nd SENATE/2020/27155 dated 16/07/2020 and in view of continuing onslaught of COVID-19 pandemic, the following Evaluation scheme to UG and PG students (except final year) and PhD scholars for even semester of Academic session 2019-20 is hereby notified. These special provisions will override the corresponding clauses as laid down in respective Ordinances (Bachelor, Master and Doctoral).

A. Fulfilment of Attendance Requirement

It shall be assumed that all students fulfill the minimum attendance requirement of 75% i.e. there shall be no case of short attendance.

B. Evaluation Scheme

1. Courses having Lectures and Tutorials

The weightage of Theory and Practical components shall be in the proportion to Credits assigned to these components.
