About the Institute:

Located in Hamirpur district of Himachal Pradesh, NIT Hamirpur enjoys a scenic environment and pleasant weather. Established in the year 1986, as REC Hamirpur, NIT Hamirpur has been declared as the Institute of National Importance under the Act of Parliament, 2007. At present, NIT Hamirpur offers four years B.Tech. degree in Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Chemical Engineering and Materials Science & Engineering, Engineering Physics, and Mathematics & Computing and a five year B.Arch. degree. The Institute has also introduced five years Dual Degree leading to Bachelor and Master of Technology in Computer Science & Engineering and Electronics & Communication Engineering. The Institute also offers M.Tech./M.Arch. /MSc/MBA Programmes with various specializations. In 2006, Ph.D. programme was started in all disciplines. Thus, NIT Hamirpur is making all efforts to move ahead towards the national goal of producing more and more number of quality postgraduates and doctorates.

The Walk-in is scheduled on **12th August 2026** for admissions to M.Tech./ M.Arch. Self- Sponsored (Full Time) Programmes. **The Seats remaining vacant after CCMT 2026 counselling shall also be filled through this Walk-in. A waiting list shall be prepared by the Departments/Centre based upon merit and candidates shall be called for admissions accordingly. The dates for calling the waitlisted candidates by the Departments/ Centre shall be from 21st August to 24th August 2026.**

Call for Applications:

- ❖ The candidates are required to appear for Walk-in Test/ Interview in the respective Department on **August 12, 2026** at 09:00 AM.
- ❖ Application processing fee of **Rs. 600/-** for **GEN/EWS/OBC** and **Rs. 300/-** for **SC/ST/PwD** category candidates is required to be paid online through SBI Collect (<https://www.onlinesbi.sbi/sbicollect> and enter the organization name as NIT HAMIRPUR), on or before **August 12, 2026** under the Payment Category (PG ENTRANCE EXAM APP FEE). If a candidate wishes to appear in more than one Department then he/she is required to submit separate Application Form and processing fee for each Department/Centre. The Application processing fee is non-refundable.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. General Criteria

- ❖ For admission in any Master Programme the applicant must have CGPI of 6.5 on a 10-point scale (or equivalent) or 60% marks in case of Open/EWS/OBC-NCL candidates in qualifying degree. Whereas in case of SC/ST/PwD candidates, a CGPI of 6.0 on a 10-point scale (or equivalent) or 55% marks in qualifying degree (B.Tech./ B.E./ B.Arch.) shall be applicable.
- ❖ In case both CGPA/CGPI and percentage are mentioned, then only CGPA/CGPI would be considered. Conversion from CGPA/CGPI to percentage or vice versa given by individual Institute/University will not be allowed.

2. Master of Technology (M Tech):
 - ❖ Bachelor's Degree or equivalent degree in appropriate branch of Engineering/Technology/Architecture OR Master's Degree in appropriate discipline of Science.
3. Master of Architecture (M Arch)
 - ❖ Bachelor's Degree or equivalent degree in appropriate branch of Architecture of minimum five year duration.

Short-listing / Selection Criteria:

- ❖ The admission to M. Tech./M.Arch. Self-Sponsored (Full Time) programme will be based on the performance in Interview conducted by the respective Departments/Centre. The merit list will be based on the performance in the interview out of 50 marks. However, screening test may be conducted by the Department/Centre for shortlisting purpose, if required.
- ❖ No interim correspondence will be entertained.

Programme Features:
