2. Conducting Technical Activities at NIT Hamirpur and sponsoring students for participating in Technical Activities outside NIT Hamirpur.
3. Conducting Sports Events at NIT Hamirpur and sponsoring students for participation in Sports Activities outside NIT Hamirpur.

RULES FOR CONDUCTING SPORTS EVENTS AT NIT HAMIRPUR AND SPONSORING STUDENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN SPORTS ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE NIT HAMIRPUR:

1. AIMS AND OBJECTS:

- i) To inculcate the spirit of sportsmanship in students which results in the form of awareness for the importance of sports and games in day to day life.
- ii) To benefit students to move competently and successfully not only in sports, games and exercises but also in all dynamic lifespan circumstances.
- iii) To advance the standard of sports in India and to make efforts for the development of character and morals through sports between the Individuals.
- iv) To conduct Annual Tournaments of various games and sports such as Inter-Branche, Inter year etc.
- v) To promote the spirit of fellow by organizing and taking part in the Inter-Technology University Sports Association (ITUSA) Northern Region, Inter NITs and other parallel Institutes.

2. CONSTITUTION OF SPORTS COMMITTEE:

There shall be Institute Sports Committee (ISC) for organizing and regulating the sports activities of the Institute. Constitution of the committee shall be as under:

3. DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE INSTITUTE SPORTS COMMITTEE:

ISC shall help/advise Dean (Student Welfare) in organizing Sports activities of the Institute. Its general functions will be: -

- i. To make rules, organize, conduct and control sports tournaments and other sports activities in which the Institute should participate with the approval of the Director.
- ii. To enforce these rules, any matter of controversy and dispute shall be referred to the Director whose decision shall be final.
- iii. To prepare Annual Budget for games and sports.
- iv. To oversee judicious utilization of Sports Funds.
- v. To write off irrecoverable/unserviceable dues and items of stock with the approval of the Director.
- vi. To frame new rules/amendments in the existing rules with the approval of the Director.
- vii. To introduce new activities with the approval of the Director.

4. ORGANIZATION OF TOURNAMENTS:

Tournaments shall be conducted annually for various outdoor/indoor games as decided by the ISC:

- i) The tournaments shall be open to all the bonafide students of the Institutewhose names exist on the Institute rolls.

- ii) A class and Branch can enter one team in one game.
- iii) Proper record of team members indicating best timing/distance etc. achieved in various athletic events of the tournaments shall be maintained by the sports department.
- iv) Referee/Umpire/Judge shall be appointed by the sports department of NIT, Hamirpur in consultation with coordinator sports committee.
- v) Whenever an individual player or a team is suspended for misconduct or unsporting behavior during the course of play, such suspension shall remain in force till the case is decided by the sports committee.
- vi) In case a team does not appear on the field for playing or walks out of the field of play during a tournament it shall be disqualified and the match awarded to the other team.
- vii) The sports committee shall decide the draws of the matches.

5. SELECTION OF INSTITUTE TEAM CAPTAIN:

The appointment of the Captain shall be made by the ISC on the recommendation of Faculty Incharge (Sports) to Associate Dean (Student Activities), The selection of Captains shall be made on the following criteria:

- i. Performance of the Player in Inter year & Inter branch tournament or trial conducted by the sports committee.
- ii. Seniority of a player in the Institute.
- iii. Personality and leadership quality.
- iv. Satisfactory conduct.
- v. Participation in games and sports on regular basis.

6. PARTICIPATION OF STUDENTS OUTSIDE THE INSTITUTE:

The bonafide students of the institute whose names exist on the Institute rolls can participate in any tournament organized by NITs and other comparable institutions, preferably in Northern Regions without disturbing Academic Calendar of the Institute. Attendance benefit will be given to the students during participation in the above tournaments, in case the attendance should fall below 75%.

7. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION FOR INSTITUTE TEAM:

Criteria for selection of Institute teams shall be made by the ISC on the basis of Performance of the Player in the Inter Branches, Inter-Year-Tournaments and Tournaments conducted by the ISC.

8. SELECTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN TEAMS FOR TOURNAMENT OUTSIDE NIT, HAMIRPUR:

- i. Shall be based on participation/performance in games played at NIT, Hamirpur or through selection trials.
- ii. Shall be on recommendations of team Captain and Faculty Incharge (Sports)
- iii. Any student willing to participate will be permitted to participate only once in a semester.

9. TRAVELLING / DAILY ALLOWANCES AND REFRESHMENTS:

Daily allowance of Rs. 300/- will be paid for participating in the tournament organized by NITs and other parallel institutes to the members of the institute team per head per day (including the day of departure and arrival) and Rs. 50/- shall be paid as a refreshment to the participant's students per match per head.

For attending such sports events, the sponsored and participating students shall be reimbursed ordinary bus/rail fare on production of journey tickets by the shortest route.

In case the sports event is being organized by a nearby institution (within 550 kms. approximate one way) participating students have been sponsored, the Institute Bus may be deployed after necessary approval from the Director.

Registration fee, if applicable for participation in any sports event shall be reimbursed on production of proper receipt.

10. TROPHIES AND CERTIFICATES:

i. All Trophies and National/Sports awards are the property of the Institute sports department. As such these shall be kept in the custody of the Sports Officer. Sports Trophy received by the students or any other authority shall be passed on to the Secretary, ISC/Faculty Incharge (Sports), as soon as possible. Trophy for general Championship is to be awarded to a class/year that secures highest points in all the Games. There are 5 points for a Winner and 3 points for the Runner-up Team.

ii. Trophy for Best Athlete (Boys & Girls) shall be awarded to the student whose scores highest points, as under:

iii. The ISC with the approval of the Director shall decide the numbers of prizes to be awarded in Games and Sports.

iv. Prizes and Certificates of merit signed by the Dean(SW), Associate Dean (Student Activity and Clubs) & Faculty Incharge (Sports) shall be awarded to the individual, members of Winning and Runners-up teams in Games and to individuals securing First, Second and Third positions in Athletics, and also to the ISC members and best volunteers etc.

11. INCURRING EXPENDITURE FROM SPORTS FUNDS:

The following expenses can be incurred from the Sports Fund:

- i. Refereeing of matches and payment of affiliation fee.
- ii. Entry fee to any other tournament. Payment of protest fee, late fee, fine or subscription to the District, State or National Tournaments.
- iii. Award of Prizes at the Annual Sports prizes distribution.
- iv. Purchase of sports Kits, Sports articles/equipment and items etc.
- v. TA/DA allowances and refreshment to teams for playing matches and other sports activities.

- vi. For organization of annual sports meet & various other tournaments at NIT, Hamirpur (HP).
- vii. Participation in tournaments outside NIT, Hamirpur (HP).
- viii. Any other with the approval of Director.

12. SPORTS KITS:

Sports Kits shall be provided to the members of the institute team who will participate in Inter NITs and other comparable institutions or National level tournaments once in a year on non-returnable basis as follows:

1. T-Shirts and Shorts for all Games.
2. T-Shirts and lower for Cricket.
3. T-Shirts, Shorts, Stocking and Football Shoes for Football team.
4. T-Shirts, Shorts and stockings for Hockey Team.
5. Track Suit for all student teams participating outside Institute.

13. FUND MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET:

To facilitate above sports activities throughout the year, each student will be charged Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) during registration in each semester and the accumulated amount will be maintained under a separate head. This rule is subject to revision from time to time as per exigencies. The Institute shall maintain the account of this fund.
