#### Evaluation Scheme for Final Year UG & PG Students and Research Scholars in the Final Stage of their PhD Programme (Session 2019-20, Even Semester only)

The Senate of the Institute, in its 1<sup>st</sup> Emergent Meeting (in consideration of the letter F.No.33-6/2020-TS.III, dated May 1, 2020 of the Under Secretary NITs, MHRD) has resolved to approve the following evaluation scheme for Final year UG & PG Students and Research Scholars in the Final Stage of their PhD Programme (Session 2019-20, Even Semester only):

#### **A. Fulfillment of Attendance Requirement**

It shall be assumed that all students fulfill the minimum attendance requirement of 75% i.e. there shall be no case of short attendance.

#### **B. Evaluation of UG Final Year (8<sup>th</sup> Semester B.Tech./Dual Degree and 10<sup>th</sup> Semester B.Arch.)**
