Academic Activities for UG and PG Students (except final year) and Ph.D. Scholars During June 12, 2020 to July 15, 2020 in the Wake of COVID-19 Pandemic

To ensure the health safety and security of students, faculty and staff, all academic activities shall continue to run in the digital/online mode during June 12, 2020 to July 15, 2020 in the Wake of COVID-19 Pandemic. Therefore, the UG and PG Students (except final year) and Ph.D. Scholars shall be engaged in academic activities during above mentioned period (may continue further till subsequent notification in this regard) as follows:

1. 6th Semester B.Tech./Dual Degree and 8th Semester B.Arch.

- i. For each Theory Course, the concerned teacher of the Course shall engage students in the form of giving Term Project related to the Course by making a team of maximum three students (the choice of team may be given to the students). Such Term Project work will have significant weightage comparable to Mid Semester Examination while evaluating student performance for current semester grading of that particular Theory Course.
- ii. For each Lab Course, the concerned teacher of the Course shall engage students in the form of giving Virtual Experiments/Software Practices related to the Course by making a team of maximum three students (the choice of team may be given to the students). Such Virtual Experiments/Software Practices will have significant weightage while evaluating student performance for current semester grading of that particular Lab Course.
- iii. The student may join online training/internship/course or continue with already started industrial training/internship for at least one month period. For 6th Semester B.Tech./Dual Degree students, this will be evaluated for grading as part of their 7th semester.

2. 8th Semester Dual Degree

Students may start research work on M.Tech. Dissertation under already allotted Supervisor.

3. 4th/2nd Semester B.Tech./Dual Degree and 6th/4th/2nd Semester B.Arch.

- i. For each Theory Course, the concerned teacher of the Course shall engage students in the form of giving Term Project related to the Course by making a team of maximum three students (the choice of team may be given to the students). Such Term Project work will have significant weightage comparable to Mid Semester Examination while evaluating student performance for current semester grading of that particular Theory Course.
- ii. For each Lab Course, the concerned teacher of the Course shall engage students in the form of giving Virtual Experiments/Software Practices related to the Course by making a team of maximum three students (the choice of team may be given to the students). Such Virtual Experiments/Software Practices will have significant weightage while evaluating student

performance for current semester grading of that particular Lab Course.

iii. The student may join online training/internship/course for better learning experience and exposure. Students may work on projects related to real-life problems such as issues concerning COVID-19 pandemic. For 6th Semester B.Arch. students, this will be evaluated for grading as part of their 7th semester. For others, this may help them later to earn better grade in General Proficiency.

4. 2nd Semester M.Tech./M.Arch./MSc/MBA and Ph.D. Scholars Undergoing Course Work

- i. For each Theory Course, the concerned teacher of the Course shall engage students in the form of giving Term Project related to the Course to each student. Such Term Project work will have significant weightage comparable to Mid Semester Examination while evaluating student performance for current semester grading of that particular Theory Course.
- ii. For each Lab Course, the concerned teacher of the Course shall engage students in the form of giving Virtual Experiments/Software Practices related to the Course to each student. Such Virtual Experiments/Software Practices will have significant weightage while evaluating student performance for current semester grading of that particular Lab Course.
- iii. The MBA students are advised to join online industrial training/internship or continue with already started industrial training/internship for at least one month period. This online industrial training/internship will be evaluated for grading as part of their 3rd semester course (MB-633).
- iv. PhD scholars undergoing Course Work shall be evaluated for their Semester Progress through online presentation to their respective SRC.

5. Ph.D. Scholars Other than Under Course work and Thesis submitted

All such PhD scholars shall be evaluated for their Comprehensive Examination, Delivery of State-of-the-Art Seminar, Evaluation of Semester Progress, Paper Writing and Thesis Writing.

6. The following Academic Activity shall be common for the above points from Sr. No. 1 to 4: Teachers shall deliver course material, if any, through digital/online mode and students will remain in touch with concerned teachers for learning and clarity of concepts related to Theory Courses/ Lab Courses.
