Programme Objectives

The primary objective of this FDP is to provide an opportunity for faculty members, research scholars and PG students to enrich their knowledge about recent or innovative techniques used for effective teaching and research. The FDP will start with an overview of innovative techniques for transforming pedagogy to assist the participants understands the importance of these tools in changing academic scenarios. This FDP is planned into two parts: technical session and hands-on session. The technical session part of the FDP will focus on the use of recent pedagogy and innovative ICT tools in teaching and research. For the same, online/live lectures sessions delivered by subject experts along with providing comprehensive tutorials and practice notes, training sessions, follow up sessions and discussion forums to gain deeper insights on the topics. The hands-on session part will extend the discussion to address the practical evaluation of teaching and research tools and techniques such as simulations, review through bibliometric and imparting knowledge of R Studio, AMOS and PLS Softwares and many more. The pedagogy will include practical examples, group discussions, conceptual lectures, case analysis and experience sharing are some of the techniques that would be employed in this programme. The participants would be expected to actively participate and engage in online session discussions. Many important tips would be shared to deliver the content smartly in shorter as well as longer run in career as a researcher and academician.
