Category for the Academic Year 2024-2025 through Walk-in on 5th August 2024

About the Institute:

Located in Hamirpur district of Himachal Pradesh, NIT Hamirpur enjoys a scenic environment and pleasant weather. Established in the year 1986, as REC Hamirpur, NIT Hamirpur has been declared as the Institute of National Importance under the Act of Parliament, 2007. At present, NIT Hamirpur offers four years B.Tech. degree in Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Chemical Engineering and Materials Science & Engineering, and a five year B.Arch. degree. The Institute has also introduced five years Dual Degree leading to Bachelor and Master of Technology in Computer Science & Engineering and Electronics & Communication Engineering. From the Academic Year 2020-21, the Institute is also admitting candidates in two new B.Tech. programmes namely Engineering Physics, and Mathematics & Computing. The Institute also offers M.Tech./M.Arch. /MSc/MBA programmes with various specializations. In 2006, Ph.D. programme was started in all disciplines. Since, then many candidates have been registered for pursuing their Ph.D. in this Institute. Thus, NIT Hamirpur is making all efforts to move ahead towards the national goal of producing more and more number of quality postgraduates and doctorates.

The Walk-in is scheduled on **5th August 2024** for admissions to M.Tech./ M.Arch. Self- Sponsored (Full Time) programmes. **The Seats remaining vacant after CCMT 2024 counselling shall also be filled through this Walk-in. A waiting list shall be prepared based upon merit and candidates shall be called for admissions accordingly.**

Master Programmes Offered:

Seats are available for the M.Tech./ M.Arch. (Self-Sponsored) programmes offered by different Departments of the Institute mentioned as under. No scholarship is provided by the Institute for admissions under this category. The reservations will be as per the reservation policy of the Government of India notified from time to time.

Call for Application:

- ❖ The candidates are required to appear for Walk-in Test/ Interview in the respective Department on 5th August 2024 at 09:00 AM
- ❖ Application processing fee of **Rs. 600** for **GEN/EWS/OBC** and **Rs. 300** for **SC/ST/PwD** category candidates is required to be paid online through SBI Collect (<https://www.onlinesbi.com/sbicollect>), on or before 5th August 2024, under the category (M. Tech. / M. Arch. Application Fee Through SBI Collect). If a candidate wishes to appear in more than one Department then he/she is required to submit separate application and processing fee for each Department. The Application processing fee is non-refundable.

Eligibility Criteria:

For admission in any Master Programme the applicant must have CGPI of 6.5 on a 10-point scale (or equivalent) or 60% marks in case of Open/EWS/OBC-NCL candidates in qualifying degree. Whereas in case of SC/ST/PwD candidates, a CGPI of 6.0 on a 10-point scale (or equivalent) or 55% marks in qualifying degree (B.Tech./ B.E./ B.Arch.) shall be applicable.

Short-listing / Selection Criteria:

The admission to M. Tech./M.Arch. Self Sponsored (Full Time) programme will be based on the performance in written test (MCQ) or Interview of 50 Marks, conducted by the respective Departments. No interim correspondence will be entertained.

Programme Features:

The programme features & other details may be seen in the Master Ordinances, Course Structure and Syllabus as available on the Institute Website www.nith.ac.in.
