A. Examination and Evaluation

S.No	Type of Course	Weightage of Supplementary Examination	Duration of Examination	Mode and Pattern of Examination
1.	Theory	50%	60 Minutes	▪ Mode: Online/digital ▪ Pattern: MCQ consisting of minimum 25 questions
2.	Lab/Practical	40%	60 Minutes	▪ Mode: Online/digital ▪ Pattern: MCQ consisting of minimum 20 questions
3.	Other than Theory/Lab/Practical	As given in Ordinances/ Course Curriculum	60 Minutes	▪ Mode: Online/digital ▪ Pattern: MCQ consisting of minimum 20 questions

B. Assignment of Faculty Member(s) to a Course


Based on the students' registration for Supplementary Examination, the Academic Section shall provide list of courses (theory, lab/practical, etc.) and concerned registered students (along with their mobile number and email id) to the Departments. Thereafter, the concerned HoD shall assign faculty members to these courses for the purpose of examination, evaluation and grade submission.

D. All other exceptional issues will be considered and decided on case to case basis.


