





Message from the Head of Department








About NIT Hamirpur

Central Library




Computer Center



Eligibility Criteria and Selection Procedure

A candidate who has either secured or is likely to secure Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology with First division or equivalent CGPA is eligible for admission subject to production of final year/semester mark-sheet by 15th of Sep. 2017. Selection will be based on application rating, performance in CMAT for domestic students (written test in case of non CMAT candidates may be conducted by the institute) and the candidate's performance in the group discussion and personal interview round. Post qualification work experience in industrial organizations of repute will also be given due consideration. CMAT qualified candidates will be considered on priority and written test would be conducted only for the seats left vacant. The institute follows Government of India norms regarding reservation of seats for qualified Scheduled Caste/Tribe candidates.
