Item No. 25.2: To consider the proposal for Number of Ph.D. Candidates with Scholarship Amongst the Faculty Members.

Senate considered and decided that each faculty member may be allotted only one Ph.D candidate with MHRD scholarship in a academic session with maximum of three such Ph.D. candidates being supervised by a faculty member at a given point of time. In total a faculty member can supervise maximum of 06 (Six) Ph.D candidates inclusive of all types of candidates.

Other conditions remain same as per PG manual.

To consider the proposal regarding Project Staff Appointed Under Projects to get Enrolled into Ph.D. after Completing the Process of Ph.D. Admission.

After detailed deliberations, Senate decided that discussion on wider platform needs to be carried out before taking any final decision. For this data may be collected on related matter from other premier/reputed Institutes like IITs, NITs etc. After obtaining feedback/input, the item will again be put up for discussion in the next Senate meeting.

Item No. 25.4: To consider the proposal for Making Provision to Review the Annual Progress of Research Work of Ph.D. Scholars by External Examiner.

After discussion, the Senate decided to drop the item. Further it was decided that status quo prior to introduction of this provision will be maintained because it was felt that this modification would not have provided desired results as it would not have been appropriate for an expert with a given specialization to evaluate group of Ph.D. candidates.

Item No. 25.5: To consider the proposal for Reconstitution of Review Committee for Enhancement of Ph.D Scholarship After Completion of Two Years.

In this regard, the Senate members were of the opinion that external expert should be retained in the evaluation Committee. However the existing Committee may be modified as follows:

Further, it was decided that the review Committee will follow the following eligibility criteria at the time of recommending enhancement of fellowships:

- One paper published / accepted for publication in SCI/SCOPUS/Web of Science journal.
- (ii) Enhanced fellowships will be released from the date of eligibility after successful presentation by the candidate and consequent satisfactory recommendation of the Committee.
- (iii) In case performance is found unsatisfactory then one more re-evaluation will be done after one year from the last such evaluation and the enhancement of fellowship will be effective from the date of the satisfactory recommendation of the review Committee. No further review will be done after two unsuccessful attempts.

Item No. 25.6: To consider the proposal regarding Issue of Teaching Load for the Subject "Research Methodology" to be Taught to all M.Tech. Students in Place of Self Study Course.

Resolution: The issue of teaching load for the subject "Research Methodology" was considered and Senate decided to continue with old/existing scheme till final appropriate implementable decisions are taken.

Item No. 25.7: To consider the proposal for Major Projects Carried by MBA Students.

It was also decided to send only soft copy of the project work/dissertation to the external expert, however hard copy may also be sent on request.
