PART - III NEW ITEMS

SENATE/28/2019-07/05: To consider and approve drafts of Bachelor, Master and Doctoral Ordinances

It was decided in the 25th meeting of SENATE that Bachelor, Master, and Doctoral Ordinances shall be prepared in accordance with the provisions contained in clause 27 of NITSER Act-2007. Accordingly, three separate committees were constituted to prepare the draft of these ordinances. The committees after series of meetings/deliberations prepared the draft documents for

(i) Bachelor Ordinances

(ii) Master Ordinances

(iii) Doctoral Ordinances

These documents have been further modified to maintain consistency among three documents in terms of formatting, structuring of contents, composition of committees, academic requirements, evaluation and grading, etc. in a common committee consisting of Director, Dean (Academic) and Conveners of all the three committees. The final draft of (i) Bachelor Ordinances (ii) Master Ordinances and (iii) Doctoral Ordinances is placed for consideration and deliberation of the SENATE so that it can be implemented from the session 2019-20. The proposed draft of Ordinances is enclosed at Annexure I, II and III respectively.

It is further proposed that if some minor modifications are required to be made during implementation, it can be done by a 03-member committee constituted at the Institute level and same will be placed before the SENATE for approval in its next meeting.

Decision:

The SENATE approved all three proposed drafts, one each for Bachelor Ordinances, Master Ordinances and Doctoral Ordinances with minor additions/deletions in some of the clauses. The SENATE also resolved to recommend all Ordinances to the BOG for final approval. The Ordinances for Bachelor Programmes, Master Programmes and Doctoral Programmes as recommended by the SENATE are enclosed at Annexure-X1. Further, the SENATE approved their implementation from the current Academic year 2019-20 and also resolved that minor modifications if required to be made during implementation can be done by three-member committee, preferably comprising of conveners of each Ordinance committee at the Institute level and shall be placed in the next SENATE meeting for approval.

SENATE/28/2019-07/06: To consider proposal of new Course Curriculum (Course Structure and Syllabi) for all Master Programmes

The course structure along with syllabi for (a) M.Tech. (b) M.Arch. (c) MBA and (d) M.Sc. programmes listed in Annexure (6A, 6B, 6C and 6D) duly recommended by the DPGC(s) of different Departments/ Centres and subsequently recommended by the SPGC in its meeting held on 01/07/2019 is submitted for consideration and deliberation. In pursuance of the approval accorded by the BOG in its 37th meeting vide Item No. BOG/MIN/37/2019-05/23 and BOG/MIN/37/2019-05/24 held on 03/05/2019, M.Tech. (Chemical Engineering) in Chemical Engineering Department and M.Tech. (Manufacturing) in Mechanical Engineering Department are to be

started from Academic Session 2020-2021. To this end course structures along-with syllabi duly proposed by DPGCs Chemical Engineering Department and Mechanical Engineering Department respectively and further recommended by SPGC in its meeting held on 01/07/2019 are placed before the Senate for discussion and approval.

Out of 18M.Tech. programmes, the new course curriculum for 10 M. Tech programmes shall commence from the session 2019-20 and for the remaining 08 M.Tech. programmes shall be implemented from the session 2020-21, whereas the new course curriculum for M. Arch., MBA, and M.Sc. programmes shall be implemented from the session 2019-20.

The proposal is placed for detailed deliberation and decision please.

Decision:

The SENATE approved the new course curriculum (course structure and syllabi) for all 23 Master Programmes (M.Tech./M.Arch./MSc/MBA), out of which new course curriculum for 10 M.Tech., 01 M.Arch., 03 MSc and 01 MBA Programmes shall be implemented from Academic year 2019-20 and for the remaining new 08 M.Tech. Programmes from Academic year 2020-21. The SENATE also resolved that notification in this regard shall be issued immediately without waiting for the confirmation from the SENATE members. The course curriculum of all new Master Programmes as approved by the SENATE is enclosed as Annexure-X2.

SENATE/28/2019-07/07: To consider the revision in Fee Structure for UG, PG and Ph.D. students

Keeping in view the need to rationalize Fee Structure of UG, PG and Ph.D. students, a committee under the Chairmanship of Dean (P&D) was constituted to review the existing Fee Structure and propose a revision of Fee Structure for UG, PG and Ph.D. students. The proposed Fee Structure as submitted by the constituted Committee is placed as Annexure – 7 (A, B, C) for consideration, decision and subsequent recommendation to FC and BOG for approval, so that the same can be implemented by the Institution from the Academic Session 2020-21.

The proposal is placed for detailed deliberation and decision please.

Decision:

The SENATE approved the proposal submitted by the constituted committee for revision of Fee structure of all the three Programmes (UG, PG and PhD) with minor modifications and also resolved to recommend the same for final approval in the next meeting of FC/BOG. The Fee structure for Bachelor, Master and Doctoral Programmes as recommended by the SENATE is enclosed at Annexure-X3.

SENATE/28/2019-07/08: To consider the proposal of starting New M.Tech. Computer Science and Engineering (Artificial Intelligence) Programme in CSED

The course structure along with syllabi for new M.Tech, Computer Science and Engineering (Artificial Intelligence) programme duly proposed by the DPGC of the Computer Science and Engineering Department and subsequently

recommended by the SPGC in its meeting held on 01/07/2019 is submitted for consideration, deliberation and approval of the SENATE as per Annexure -8.

The proposal is placed for detailed deliberation and decision please.

Decision:

The SENATE approved the proposal to start new Master Programme in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) Department as M.Tech. Computer Science and Engineering (Artificial Intelligence) without any additional financial liability on the Institute. The SENATE also resolved to recommend the decision for the final approval of BOG as per NIT Statutes clause 8(xii). If approved, new M.Tech. programme shall replace the existing M.Tech. (Mobile computing) from Academic Year 2020-21 without changing the present M.Tech. intake of the Department.

SENATE/28/2019-07/09: To consider the proposal for renaming the Department of Mathematics and Scientific Computing

It is submitted that as per resolution of 23rd meeting of the SENATE vide Item No. 23.7 and 23.8 and ratified by BOG/ MIN/30/2016/09/21 in its 31st meeting held on 13/12/2016, the Institute is charging fee for educational verification @ Rs. 1000 including postal charges within India and \$100 including postal charges for outside India as per Annexure – 12(I).

In view of the above, the same verification fee is being charged/ asked by the Institution from all the State / Central Govt. Department and other agencies, who are requesting to verify the educational certificates/ documents of students of this institution getting employment in said Departments. One of the Central Government Departments denied paying the verification fee with the remarks that there is no such provision for payment of fee by the Govt. Department for verification of officers appointed in their office as per Annexure 12(II). However, there are no such orders/ directions of the Govt. of India available to waive off such type of fee being charged by the Universities/ Educational Institutions.

Decision:

The SENATE approved the waiver of educational verification fee to Government Departments/Organizations.
